### **Nottingham wins three of four at Penn-Jersey Duals in Pennsylvania**

**Dec. 29:** Nottingham's wrestling team had a strong showing at the Penn-Jersey Duals, held at Harry S. Truman High, by winning three of four matches. The squad is 5-1 this season.

The Swamprats saw pins from Jancel Nunez (170 pounds), Jared Lavarra (182) and Wroway Williams (195) propel them to a 39-38 victory over Hillsborough. Nottingham also got pins from Jordan Lebo (120) and Justin Dempsey (132), a decision from Hector Davila (126) and forfeit win from Hector Comulado at heavyweight.

Nottingham got pins Nunez, Williams and Kevin Meneus (220) to lock up a 41-37 triumph over Interboro. Davila and Dempsey also recorded pins while Josh Magee (106) won by technical fall and Hamzah Mohammed (113) was victorious by forfeit.

There was less drama in the Swamprats' 72-10 win over Roman Catholic High. Nottingham received six victories by forfeit in addition to getting pins from Magee, Jacob Kouroume (126), John Pinos (138), Waleed Abouelela (145), Sidibrima Massaquoi (152) and Jervaughn Davis (220).

Nottingham's setback came against Central Bucks South, 48-23. Pinos and Davis had pins for the Swamprats while Dempsey won a major decision and Davila and Nunez both won decisions.

The next match for Nottingham will be Jan. 3 at West Windsor-Plainsboro North.
